Who can be a member?

Any Cree individual, partnership, organization or communitiy controlled by a majority of Cree beneficiaries engaged in outfitting or tourism activities within the traditional territory of Eeyou Istchee is eligible for membership.

Partnerships and organizations have to appoint an individual to represent them and let COTA / EIT know who that person is.

As a member, you are eligible to vote at member meetings.

Access to resources such as Tourism Ownership: My Business Builder	There is no charge for using our resources, whereas non-members would have to pay up to \$100 each for workbooks, textbooks, and manuals on the market.
Training programs and workshops	Some training programs charge up to \$4,000 in tuition. Our training programs and workshops are offered at minimal cost.
COTA/EIT Annual General Meeting	Registration to the AGM is free and you are eligible for a travel subsidy. Great opportunity to network with other Cree involved in the tourism industry.
